Y Cynhyrchiad

BLE MAE'R DAIL YN HEDFAN yw ail gynhyrchiad rhyngweithiol arbenigol Arad Goch i blant bach 2 - 8 oed sy'n defnyddio pethau natur fel rhan bwysig o'r weithgaredd. Crëwyd y sioe gan Jeremy Turner, Cyfarwyddwr Artistig Arad Goch a'r actores Ffion Wyn Bowen.

Mae'r cynhyrchiad yn addas i theatrau, neuaddau cymunedol ac ysgolion ac mae'r perfformiad yn digwydd y tu allan, mewn maes chwarae, parc neu goedwig a'r tu fewn. Os nad oes gofod tu allan gellir perfformio'r cyfan tu mewn.

The Production

WHERE THE LEAVES BLOW is Arad Goch's second interactive production for small children aged 2 - 8 using natural resources as a focus for the performance. The performance was developed by Arad Goch's Artistic Director Jeremy Turner and actress Ffion Wyn Bowen. The production is suitable for theatres, community venues and schools and is performed in an outside space such as a playground, park or forest and also inside. The performance can be performed inside if there is no suitable outside space.

Sgiliau/ Skills

Emosiynol: mae'r cymeriadau yn arddangos nifer o emosiynau gwahanol wrth fynd ati i greu straeon a sefyllfaoedd - syndod, hapusrwydd, gwrthod, cynorthwyo, dychryn, cyffro, sbeit, cymodi, gofalu - deall ei gilydd. Mae rhain fel drych o brofiadau'r gynulleidfa ac fe'u defnyddir i helpu'r plant bach i ddeall eu hemosiynau'u hunain ac i ddygymod â nhw.

Emotions: the characters display an array of emotions as they create new stories and scenes - shock, happiness, unwillingness, helpfulness, fear, excitement, spitefulness, making up, caring and understanding each other. These emotions help the children to understand their own emotions and to deal with them.

Cerddoriaeth: mae'r gynulleidfa yn cael cyfle i brofi cerddoriaeth fyw a chwaraeir gan y cymeriadau ar acordeon a phib. Mae'r plant yn cael ymuno yn y canu ac mae modd iddynt ychwanegu geiriau newydd.

Music: the audience experiences live music as the characters play the accordion and whistle. The children are encouraged to sing and create their own words.

Celf: mae'r perfformiad yn dangos sut y gellir defnyddio deunyddiau naturiol i greu patrymau, siapiau a delweddau

Art: the performance demonstrates how to create patterns, images and shapes by the use of natural objects.



Sgiliau/ Skills

Rhifedd a Gwyddoniaeth: defnyddio brigau i greu patrymau, creu rhythmau gyda choed a cherrig, ystyried cyflymdra gyda'r car a wneir o froc mor, gweld cydbwysedd gwrthrychau wrth adeiladu.

Numeracy and Science: using twigs to create geometric patterns, creating music and rhythms with pieces of wood and stones, consider speed with a car made from drift wood, balancing objects as they are used to build part of the story.


Llafar: wrth gael eu gwahodd i gynnig syniadau a sylwadau mae'r plant yn cael cyfle i ymarfer sgiliau llafar. Bydd eu sgwrs yn parhau yn hir ar ôl y perfformiad.

Speech: the audience/children are encouraged to share ideas and comments with the characters. The conversation will continue long after the performance
